## Day 3 : Paris – Reims – Luxembourg

Assemble in the early morning and will be greeted by our professional tour guide after which we will start our memorable Central Europe journey by transfer to Reims. Enjoy the beautiful countryside along the way to Reims, the capital of Champagne, an old province of France famous for its Champagne sparkling wine. Reims played a prominent ceremonial role in French monarchical history as the traditional site of the crowning of the kings of France since the 11<sup>th</sup> century. Thus, The Cathedral of Reims played the same role in France as Westminster Abbey did in the United Kingdom and is the most important heritage here. Later, heading to Luxembourg, the only remaining of Grand Duchy. Upon arrival, visit to the Place de Constitution, the canyon in the city and Pont Adophe. Overnight in Luxembourg or nearby city.

## Day 4 : Luxembourg – Trier – Koblenz – Frankfurt (B)

After breakfast, heading to Trier, Germany oldest city has been named as "Second Rome" since Constantine the Great administrated here. Upon arrival, visit to the famous Porta Nigra, the best-preserved roman city gate north of Alps, also the birthplace of the influential philosopher Karl Marx, the Karl Marx Haus. Later, transfer to Koblenz, also known as Deutsches Eck ("German Corner"), where the Mosel River joins the Rhine River. Guests can at their own expenses have their lunch in this famous scenic place and take a *croise*\* along the Rhine River to spend a precious moment with family and friends. Proceed to Frankfurt am Main or commonly known simply as Frankfurt, on the way stop over in Rudesheim. Upon arrival, visit to Old Opera House, Romer Platz, St. Paul's Church and the busy business street. Overnight in Frankfurt or nearby city.

Thereafter, proceed to Cologne, upon arrival, visit the Cologne Cathedral, the most famous heritage in this city, and take a walk at the famous shopping area. In the afternoon, we will proceed to Amsterdam, Holland. Upon arrival, check in to hotel and overnight in Amsterdam or nearby city.

### Day 6 : Amsterdam – The Hague\* – Amsterdam (B)

After breakfast, proceed to Amsterdam city centre and visit to Dam Square, Palace and National Monument, thereafter guests can enjoy a canal cruise along this beautiful romantic 17<sup>th</sup> century Amsterdam canal scenery at own expense\*. Later, visit to the Amsterdam famous diamond factory which is well known for their skilled diamond grinding process since the 16<sup>th</sup> century. Continue with sightseeing tour to The Hague\*, we will visit the Peace Palace where the International Court of Justice is located, Peace Palace was built between the year 1907 to 1913. Next we're off for countryside excursions to the village of Zaanse Schans, where we will visit and witness the making process of the Wooden Shoes Factory, Cheese Farm and thereafter stop for photos at the typical windmills which is one of the most important and historical architecture since the Netherlands established their country. Later, transfer back to the hotel for rest. Overnight in Amsterdam or nearby city. At night guests are welcome to join an optional tour visit to Amsterdam Red Light District which include Live Show Performance\*. (as from 24<sup>th</sup> March to 20<sup>th</sup> May is famous Amsterdam Tulip Season, we will visit to Keukenhof\* instead of The Hague and there will be extra charges of RM 110 / pax during this season).

After breakfast, enjoy the sightseeing tour to the Arc de Triomphe, drive along the busy Champs Elysees to the Place de la Concorde, where the royal and many aristocracy members were guillotined there during the Revolution. Then drive up to the Hotel des Invalides, where the Tombeau de Napoleon is located. Later, also visit to Notre Dame Cathedral and to the landmark of France, the Eiffel Tower, guest can at own expense board the Eiffel Tower\* to enjoy the panoramic view of Paris. Later, transfer to visit the glorious Palace of Versailles, built as a hunting lodge by Louis XIII, then developed to majority and taking on full royal power by Louis XIV, it remained the residence of the royal family since 1722 until the Revolution of 1789. Then transfer to hotel for overnight stay. Overnight in Paris or nearby
